1. Please give a brief overview of the assessment data you collected this year.

The HIMT program evaluated the outcome: Evaluate, use and integrate information technology to support medical decision making and processes.

The question considered was –

Students enrolled in HIMT 350 Statistics for Healthcare during the fall 2017 and spring 2018 semesters will be included in this assessment.

Goal: 90% of students who complete the assignment will earn 70% or higher on Quiz 23 (**Note that the course was revised in 2017 and the assignment moved to Lesson 7)
