Graduate Student Graduation Survey: 2017-2018

In August 2017, December 2017, and May 2018, 123 students received master's degrees from UWGB. We surveyed all students eligible to graduate in those terms. We received 55 completed questionnaires (45 percent). Students are sent several emails throughout each semester (for which they are graduating) and are invited to complete the survey then.

Graduate Student Alumni Survey: 2018

In the Summer/Fall of 2018, we surveyed UWGB alumni who received master's degrees in August 2014, December 2014, and May 2015. Of the 59 graduate alumni receiving master's degrees in this period, all had a working mailing address. Seventeen percent (10) of the alumni with a working mailing address completed the survey. Alumni were given the option of completing the survey online with both paper and email reminders sent to them.

Eighty percent of these respondents received their undergraduate degree from UW-Green Bay.

Half of the students, 50 percent, reported transferring in 12 or more credits in order to finish their degree.
