- c) SGA Think Tank (Mark)
 - We have been having some discussions about how we have four independent
 StuGov associations across all campuses.
 - 1. How do we get all of these campuses to work together?
 - 2. We want to bring them together in some fashion.
 - We have asked for two students from each of the four campuses, myself, and
 Nancy from Sheboygan
 - 1. We want students to come together and sort it out.
 - G: Initially, we have talked about having the main leadership team, me, Sarah, and Sierra meet with Mark every week.
 - 1. Some don't have speakers, one doesn't necessarily have a VP.
 - 2. We wanted to have a pres., vice pres., and speaker at all of these meetings but now it is someone who is in a higher leadership role attending these meetings.
 - 3. We are going to meeting with them pretty soon and I think they are all eager to be having this discussion.
 - a. I want the other campuses and us to get concerns out of the way so we can structure things around the concerns.
 - b. So there is no restructuring that would hurt any SGAs in any way.
 - We don't want people think their positions or their student government is going away.
 - 4. We have a few who haven't responded about a meeting time.



- a. Hopefully we would want to be done by spring break.
- Listen for updates, but that process is moving forward.
- Questions:
 - 1. Reese: This is off topic but it is parallel, I had heard that some rumors that something similar was going to happen with SUFAC's between the branch campuses as well. Do you have any info about that?
 - a. If bringing the SGA's together is going to be even more complex for SUFAC. It is going to be further down the line, it won't be happening right away because of where the funding comes. At some point we are going to get to it but not right off the bat.
 - b. It's taken three years to get to this point.
 - Originally, UW Systems said SUFAC had to stay separate, but they are backing off of it now.
- d) SGA Goal Setting
 - About committees, how to reach out to students for recruitment, new resolutions,
 it can really be anything. Things you want to see Student Government do or things
 that could possibly change. It is more of an open forum on ideas. It could relate
 to your committee meetings or to student government as a whole.
 - Mark: In the past we have talked a lot about programming but with the restrictions,
 programming is harder. We have been moving forward with legislation or policies.
 We have been able to make a difference there. Think in terms of policy or the
 programs that are offered already on campus.



Ideas:

- 1. Ted: I know the union is opening up more with opportunities, we could have an informational booth with flyers for recruitment. I don't know if we have ever done posters to try and get recruitment. But put posters up around campus to try and get people in. Half of student government is leaving in the spring, so we need more people.
- 2. Emily: Kind of going off Ted's point and half of us leaving, a lot of the chairs are graduating, so really working on finding a replacement for the chairs and get them ready to step into the position. Make sure there are good resources and information to guide them.
- 3. Joy: I think something that I really want to get done this semester is the website. I want to see that cleaned up before I head on out. And with everyone talking about recruitment, I was thinking about making some graphics and starting to spam the Facebook pages and other school social media. I still have to figure out how I want to do that but getting comments from people who are currently in SGA right now and why you joined and stuff.
- 4. Tristan: One of the things we started talking about last semester, the concourse tunnel sign project. We also talked about expanding it to other areas on the campus. I think we should bring more interest to that and it would be pretty cool for SGA to pursue and get some plans in the works.
- 5. Cora: In regard to recruitment, pretty much everything I have joined I have



gotten an email about it. Maybe we could send out a mass email to students or specific majors or to professors who could forward emails to their students.

- 6. Mark: Along with everyone who is graduating and moving on to bigger and better things. Work on transition binders and find ways to make them a virtual resource instead of an actual binder that has to be passed along.
- 7. Rachael: I have more of a question. Are we still continuing the AdHoc committee of online learning?
 - a. Yes, and the new chair will be Jasmine.
- 8. Sierra: A goal of mine is to get Canvas working and it is a source we don't really use, and I think if we could get small groups for the committees worked out it would be a really good resource.
- 9. Sarah: Using the Canvas site and recruiting heavily. Working with the concourse tunnel idea, updating the website, I think we have a lot going.
