

## UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-GREEN BAY ANNUAL PUBLIC REPORT OF ETHICS COMMITTEE

As required by Chapter UWS 8 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code (UWS 8.035), the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay has established an Institutional Ethics Committee under GB-50-23-1 which is charged with providing assessment and recommendation of policies, standards, programs, research, and education concerning the University's ethical values, ethics culture, and ethical decision-making practices. Deliberations and actions upon requests for consultation or advice are in meetings not open to the public. Records obtained in connection with requests for consultation or advice are considered confidential university information. However, summaries of advice provided by institutional ethics committees, which do not disclose the identities of persons requesting such advice, are made public in an annual report.

To meet the requirements of Chapter UWS 8, this annual report is prepared for the 2023-2024 academic year. This report has been approved by the Institutional Ethics Committee on its first meeting of the 2024-2025 Academic Year.
